She is responsible for the creation/founding of the following programs within the committee structure of branch operations: (NAACP) Youth Summit, Parents Council, and Multi-cultural Partnership. She successfully invigorated the branch by tripling its membership rolls and acquired the largest youth council unit nationwide among its 2800 youth branches.
